





- 39 graduate students






P-12 Participants

- ~37% are learning English


Ethnic Background








Engagement among P-8th Grade Participants



Engagement among 9-12th Grade Participants








Challenges

University

- Moving UC Links courses / teaching practicum courses online
- Institutional barriers
 - Limiting access to P-12 / undergraduate students
 - Developing consent forms for online participation
 - Conducting online research
- Direct impacts on undergraduate and graduate students
- Ongoing institutional support for teaching UC Links courses



Challenges

Community

- Limited access to P-12 participants and community partners
- District and school firewalls and other privacy protections
- P-12 participant access to technology and other resources
- Difficulty connecting and engaging with P-12 participants virtually
- Not adding to ongoing family stressors

 - <u>Innovations in Undergraduate Mentoring: School University Partnerships to Address Needs</u> and Inequities During Pandemic-Related Remote Learning
 - "The following innovations stemmed from the evaluation of all constituents' needs:
 - remaining in contact with service- learning partners during times of crisis;
 - connecting with families;
 - redesigning courses to provide more support and flexibility for undergraduates; and
 - supporting digital literacy needs via remote tutoring.
 - Recommendations for future success include creating flexibility in school policies to allow the most vulnerable constituents better access to mentors during the pandemic and beyond."





Innovative Responses - Research

- Jose Luis Lalueza and colleagues (Barcelona)
 - Manifesto en Tiempos de Pandemia: Por un Educacion Critica, Intergeneracional, Sostenible,
 v Comunitaria (A Manifest in a Time of Pandemic: For a Communitarian, Sustainable,
 Intergenerational and Critical Education)
 - "The emergency resulting from the coronavirus pandemic reminds us that, as human beings, we share a common challenge. Recently, it has been suggested that Covid-19 pandemic involve a "world perezhivanie", a collective and traumatic "lived experience", characterized by a profound crisis that affects not only our health, but also our economic, social, political and educational systems. In the light of this situation, we need to critically re-imagine education in 21st century. In this theoretical paper, we propose two principles designed to overcome three common biases in our understanding of learning and education. From these assumptions, we describe and illustrate the meaning and practice behind an inter-generational, personalized, shared, connected and sustainable education, based on a culture and praxis that is caring and involved, that allows us to consolidate processes of educational transformation and improvement."
